Superintendent Shout-Out

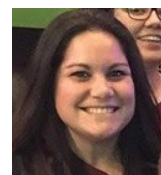
At last month's School Board Meeting, Dr. Gabe recognized a student and parent from EAC for going above and beyond to represent Evansville.

Test Taking Tips for Parents & Students
